Students:

- ⊕ Good pencil bag
- ⊕ Three packages of 5-tab dividers
- ⊕ Three-hole punch (notebook type)
- ⊕ Correction tape – NOT the bottle!
- ⊕ Good supply of #2 pencils
- ⊕ Good supply of pens: blue/black/red
- ⊕ Two black Sharpie markers – one fine/one medium
- ⊕ Highlighters – yellow/pink/blue/green
- ⊕ One 12" ruler with standard/metric markings
- ⊕ Personal pencil sharpener
