
Supply List for Sixth Grade

- ⊕ Notebook/ 3 ring Binder* - put in a portion of a packet of wide – ruled paper and keep the rest at home.
- ⊕ Notebook dividers with tabs – for seven subjects
- ⊕ 1 zippered pencil pouch or bag to fit inside binder – Be sure to put in one each of the pens/pencils/highlighters, etc. found below into your pouch for the beginning of the year.
- ⊕ 1 ruler (standard and metric – small to fit in zippered pouch)
- ⊕ Loose leaf notebook paper
- ⊕ 1 – Memory stick (jump drive, thumb drive) PC

You should place in the zippered pencil bag one of the following:

You can have extras of the above items in your pencil box (kept in your cubby) along with the following items:

- ⊕ Note cards (you will need LOTS of them!! 5 packs or more)
- ⊕ One extra package of wide-ruled notebook paper (at least)

Please bring to your homeroom teacher during the first week of school

- ⊕ 2 boxes of tissues

Specific Class Requirements

- ⊕ **Science** – two composition books (one for each semester) with GRAPH paper
- ⊕ **Social Studies** – two composition books (one for each semester) with regular lines
- ⊕ **Spanish** – two composition books (one for each semester) with regular lines
Spanish/English dictionary (to be kept at home)
- ⊕ **Language Arts** – two composition books (one for each semester) with regular lines

***Your binder will need to be thick enough to hold your pencil pouch, divider tabs with a little extra paper, and your school planner (to be handed out the first week of school). Be sure to keep a set of supplies at home in your study area!**
