Suggested School Supply List
2008 – 2009
Seventh and Eight Grade

Students:

- 1 Good pencil bag
- 1 Three-hole punch (notebook type)
- 1 Correction tape – NOT the bottle!
- 1 box of #2 pencils
- 1 box of pens: blue/black/**red**
- 2 black Sharpie markers – one fine/one medium
- 4 highlighters – yellow/pink/blue/green
- 1 12" ruler with standard/metric markings

Homeroom:

- 6 packs of COLLEGE ruled filler paper
- 3 glue sticks
- 4 boxes of tissue (kids are bigger – use more)
- 1 pair of sharp 5" scissors
- 1 softback copy of *The Miriam Webster Dictionary* (NO electronics!!)

Math:

- 1 scientific calculator (less than \$20.)
- 1 package of graph paper (4 squares /inch – 50 count)
- 4 4-pack of white board markers

Language Arts:

- 3 pocket folders – NO BRADS! (yellow/red/purple)
- 4 packages of white, lined note cards
- 1 small capacity thumb-drive device (USB)
- 1 box of red pens

Science:

- 1 2" 3-ring binder (to be shared with language arts)
- 1 set of notebook tab dividers
- 2 composition notebooks with graph paper

Spanish:

- 1 spiral notebook **per semester** to be used **exclusively** for Spanish
- 2 packs of white, lined note cards to be used for all vocabulary (Don't bring all note cards at once. Keep just a few with you for new vocabulary lists)
- 1 paperback Spanish dictionary, preferably the **Larousse Pocket Spanish Dictionary** (This dictionary can take you through high school!)

Humanities:

- 5 one pocket, brad folders (yellow/red/purple/blue/green)

Social Studies:

- 1 composition book
- 1 1" three-ring binder
- 4 one pocket folders (red/blue/yellow/green)
